**Large vessel movement - Rijnstroom IV - 19<sup>th</sup> April**

Please be aware that the 28.5m houseboat, Rijnstroom IV, will be departing the Harbour on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> April on the lunchtime high tide at approx 1400.

The vessel will be towed by a professional tug from its existing berth on Embankment Road, across towards the north shore, and will then transit through the Entrance Channel to beyond the limits of the Harbour.

BHA will be providing assistance and support in ensuring there is a clear passage at all times and announcements will be made on VHF Channel 80.

All vessels must keep well clear at all times. Thank you for your assistance in this.
